COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course provides the basic instruction for persons responsible for the delivery of emergency medical services. In addition to the 110 hours of classroom instruction, four twelve (12) hour emergency department rotations, and three twelve (12) hour ambulance rotations are required. Successful completion of a practical exam and a written exam will allow the student to be enrolled in the National Registry of EMTs and apply for a Missouri State EMT license.

PRE-REQUISITES:

A score of 60 or above on the Reading section of the Compass Test or successful completion of an English Comp I class. Student must be age eighteen (18) before taking state examination at the completion of the course.

ENROLLMENT:

Students need to complete an application for admission if not currently enrolled at Mineral Area College. The college will notify students after their application is processed and information for registering for classes will be sent. If you are a former student you may complete an Application for Admission for a Former Student form. A Reading score on the Compass Test is required. The Compass test can be scheduled by calling Nancy Crader at (573) 518-2201 after receiving the above information.
